

Prof. Dr. Herwig Brunner is the Executive Director of the Fraunhofer-Institute of Interfacial Engineering and Biotechnology and chairing as a full professor the Institute of Interfacial Technology, Faculty of Engineering, at the University of Stuttgart.



After his diploma in Chemistry and PhD in Biochemical Engineering at the Technical University of Vienna, Austria, and after a position as Assistant-Professor at the Medical School of the University Vienna, he joined pharmaceutical industry. There he got in depth experience of pharmaceutical and diagnostic relevant processes (process development and production and as Vice President R&D Biotechnology and at last as Senior Vice President managing biotechnology division as well as the Bavarian Operations at Boehringer Mannheim/Corange Ltd. (now Roche).

Prof. Brunner is Fellow of the International Institute of Biotechnology, London, and member of the Leibniz-Societaet Berlin. He acts as a Member of the Supervisory Board of some firms of the Biotech/Biomedical Industry and as advisor of the German Ministry of Research and Technology as well. He also serves as CEO of the Peter und Traudl Engelhorn-Stiftung, the first private foundation in Germany supporting Biotechnology/rDNA-Technology.
